They thank their friends in the U.S. very much for their help and for enabling them to go to school.

**Assistant Director:** Nagulo parish has continued to prosper under The Carpenter's Kids program. The Committee Members, the parish priest, the Mama Lishes (the women who cook the children breakfast), and the guardians are all working together to make the program a success. Attendance at the review was very good, and everyone was willing to share their thoughts with us. It was wonderful to see that the program has continued to progress with few problems during this year. We will continue to visit Nagulo each year to check the progress of the Kids and to resolve any issues which may arise.
