Why buy seedlings from Four Winds Farm? Our seedlings grow in an **active growing medium** prepared from **compost** made from our livestock's manure, rather than a chemically-fortified sterile soil-less mix, as is the case with most seedlings found in garden shops. **Compost heats our greenhouse**, not fossil fuel. **Roof-top solar panels** provide all our electricity. Most of our seedlings are **heirloom or open-pollinated varieties**, varieties you can't find elsewhere. We grow these **heirloom varieties** because they **taste better** than most modern hybrids, and because they **do well in backyard gardens and small farms** like ours. In addition, we purchase our seeds from **small, independent seed companies**. Our seedlings are **CERTIFIED ORGANIC** by NOFA-NY Certified Organic, LLC.
